**New Deaneries and New Deans:-** As he prepares to publish his new Pastoral Plan, the Archbishop has undertaken a major restructuring of the Archdiocese. He has decided to abolish the existing 19 Pastoral Areas and to replace them with 13 new Deaneries. The new Deaneries are larger and have new names. Formby will now be part of the new 'Sefton Coast North Deanery' which will comprise all the parishes of Southport, Ainsdale, Birkdale, Formby, Hightown and Ince Blundell. 13 new Deans have been appointed. The Archbishop has appointed Father John as the new Dean of the newly established Sefton Coast North Deanery.

**Remembrance Sunday:-** Remembrance Sunday takes place on Sunday, November 14th this year. At the Saturday Vigil Mass at St. Jerome's and the two Sunday morning Masses at Our Lady's, all those who died during the days of lockdown and restrictions in our community will be remembered and prayed for.

**Shoebbox Express:-** Very many thanks to the 131 people from our parish who sent a Christmas Shoebbox to a child in poverty this year. One of our parishioners tells us that she was once at a school in Africa when the shoeboxes were given out. Such joy and delight on all the children's faces!
